Also note that failure to comply with this directive may lead to exclusion of the name of any defaulting member of staff from the review exercise for the year under review.

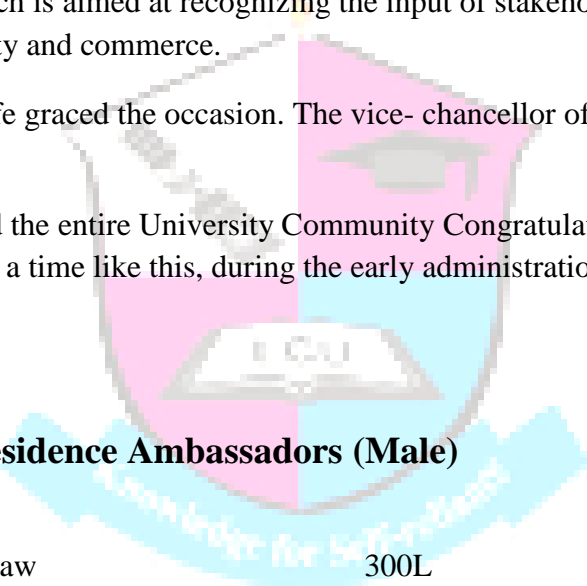
Acting Vice-Chancellor Bags Recognition Award
